Domestic Violence Bonus : New or expansion project funding dedicated solely to serving survivors	\$50,000	Nonprofits, Local Govt, Public Housing Authorities

3 agencies submitted 6 project applications

- Some projects are renewal/expansions, some are new projects
 - 4 renewal/expansion projects
 - 2 new projects
- We have three different project types:
 - 1 Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) projects
 - 2 Rapid Re-Housing (RRH) project
 - 1 Supportive Services Only (SSO)
 Coordinated Entry project

There are 2 considerations with ranking: order of project + Tiers

- Order of projects = ranked 1 through 6
- Tiers are an added level of competition

Tier 1	Funded at 93%	
Tier 2	More risky – may not be funded	

- DV Bonus project could be funded by DV Bonus (if selected nationally) in Tier 1 or Tier 2
 - HUD recommends ranking DV Bonus projects where they fall in local competition, based on local criteria, etc.
