

The Orange County Partnership to End Homelessness (OCPEH) uses this rating and ranking tool to help guide decision making for the Continuum of Care (CoC) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding opportunities. The OCPEH Project Review Committee uses this tool to evaluate project applications and to make funding recommendations to the OCPEH Leadership Team. The OCPEH Leadership Team finalizes funding recommendations, including the ranking of projects when necessary.

Background

There are three main groups that use this tool:

- 1) Project applicants are asked to fill in answers not already contained in project applications; these answers should be a 3-5 sentence short paragraph and submitted to the CoC with other supplemental materials in advance of the project application deadline
- 2) OCPEH staff provide objective measure information in the tool
- 3) OCPEH Project Review Committee members score subjective measures in the tool, using info provided by applicants, data provided by OCPEH staff and the scoring rubrics in the tool
