# Gaps Analysis Overview

- Critical (and required) part of homeless system planning
- Enables us to understand the challenges that people face when trying to access needed services
- Allows the system to pivot as needs change



# Gaps Analysis Overview

- Four buckets
  - Permanent housing
  - Services – Temporary Housing
  - Services – Connections
  - Services – Dignity
- Inputs
  - People currently experiencing homelessness
  - Service providers
  - Program and System data
  - Affordable housing and national survey data

## Permanent Housing

Goal	Progress	Partner	Notes/Next Steps
Income-based rentals	In progress – need funding and enhanced collaboration	County and Towns, CASA, Pee-wee Homes, EmPOWERment, Community Home Trust	Recent petition from OC Affordable Housing Coalition to ToCH for \$50M bond and 2 cents on property tax rate in FY24-25; Existing “Affordable” units - Referrals from Coordinated Entry? Common application?
Permanent Supportive Housing	In progress – Increased referrals	Inter-Faith Council	Build partnership btw IFC and UNC
Furniture / Household Goods	In progress – need enhanced collaboration	Lotta Love, Community Empowerment Fund	Develop referral process

## Services – Temporary Housing

Goal	Progress	Partner	Notes/Next Steps
Accessible, Housing - Focused Shelter	In progress – Revising referrals into Shelter	IFC, County and Towns	Referrals directly from Housing Help; Proposal to use 203 project for overflow shelter during inclement weather
Bridge Housing	In progress – need funding for FY24-25; cleared a licensing hurdle	Caramore and Alliance Health	Continuation funding, developing referrals through Coordinated Entry

Goal	Progress	Partner	Notes/Next Steps
24 hour bathrooms	In progress – partially filled with Wallace Deck improvement, Rosemary deck nearing completion Century Center	Town of Chapel Hill, Town of Carrboro, BuildUp, CEF, NEXT, IFC	Ongoing concerns about condition and use of bathrooms, recent petition to ToCH Council
