- **Expanded Cold Weather planning** (Staff)

OCPEH Staff have worked closely with the Criminal Justice Resource Department, IFC staff and volunteers, Chapel Hill Crisis Unit, Chapel Hill Fire Department, and County Emergency Management and Facilities to [expand cold weather options](#) when the overnight temperature drops below 32 degrees. Staff will continued to convene conversations with the Chapel Hill and Carrboro town staff and stakeholders for improved cold weather expansion for 2024.

- **Data Quality plan** (Staff)

The NC Coalition to End Homelessness (NCCEH) serves as the Orange County, Durham County and Balance of State (79 mostly rural counties) Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) data lead. They have proposed a [Data Quality plan](#) that is under review by the Data and Grants committee.
