 - Measure 1, 2, 4, and 7 – see slides for location in ART, prompts, descriptions of what info is pulled and other recommendations
- How can the APR and CAPER help monitor data?
 - Remember that EDA mode is essential for these canned dashboard reports
 - Any user can run the APR or CAPER with the right EDA mode
 - Contact the data center if EDA isn't right
 - Rex: Implications for using the incorrect EDA mode include inaccurate/incomplete reports, limited visibility for monitoring client files in HMIS, and overall less confidence in the data
 - Data Quality
 - Completeness and error rates for most required data elements
 - Outcomes
 - Length of participation, time to move-in, exit destination and income/non-cash benefit increases can be found in the APR and CAPER
- How does the APR and CAPER compare to the 0640 Data Quality report?
 - Different reports review data differently, and do not overlap 100%
- What about reporting groups?
 - Make sure to confirm the reporting group is up to date in HMIS with the data center
