2018 Point-in-Time and Housing Inventory Counts



Overall number up from last year, up 12% since 2011

- 152 people experienced homelessness on a single night
 - 113 sheltered (emergency shelter and transitional housing)
 - 39 unsheltered
- Subpopulations
 - 12 veterans
 - 19 people experiencing chronic homelessness
 - 0 unaccompanied youth
- Household types
 - 10 families
 - 19 children, 13 adults
 - 120 people living in adults-only households



Housing Inventory Count shows system capacity & utilization

- 93 Permanent Supportive Housing beds
- 15 Rapid Re-Housing beds
- 91 Shelter/Transitional Housing beds
 - +20 only on cold weather nights



Considerations for our CoC



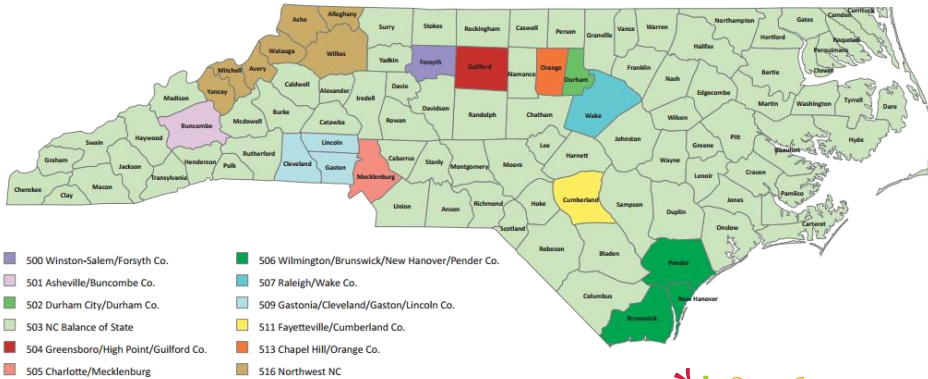
Continuum of Care (CoC) has two meanings, which is confusing

1. CoC = source of HUD funding
 - Large source of homeless funding
2. CoC = planning area
 - Geographically defined group responsible for homeless services planning & implementation
 - **OCEH serves as the CoC for Orange County**



There are 12 CoCs in North Carolina

North Carolina Continuum of Care (CoC) Primary Areas



HUD designates CoC responsibilities

- CoC governance & structure
- System operations & planning
- Designate & operate Homeless Management Information System (HMIS)
- Design coordinated entry



No changes are required but there are some opportunities afoot

- HUD incentivizing CoCs to merge
 - 5-25 Points in CoC grant competition
- CoC Collaborative Applicant review
- United Funding Agency (UFA)
 - CoC applies for all funding and subcontracts with agencies

- Workgroup to evaluate options and bring back recommendations to the Leadership Team?
 - 5-8 hours
 - June-August
